GLACIER COUNTY HEALTH EMERGENCY DECLARATION (COVID-19)

RESOLUTION NO: 2020-11.

WHEREAS, the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) Pandemic is causing widespread human and economic impacts that could significantly impact Glacier County;

WHEREAS, the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS) recognizes COVID-19 as a threat to the residents of Montana;

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Montana, pursuant to the authority vested under the Constitution and the laws of the State of Montana, Title 10, Chapter 3, MCA, and under other applicable statutes, declared that an emergency exists statewide, as defined in §§ 10-3-103 and 10-3-302, MCA.

WHEREAS, Glacier County has committed all available resources, taken all possible action to combat and to alleviate the situation and local resources may not be adequate to cope with the situation.

WHEREAS, a Health Emergency has occurred or is anticipated within the County of Glacier, on or about March 16, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Glacier County Board of Commissioners that a **Health Emergency** is hereby declared pursuant to section 10-3-402, MCA, and all provisions of the County Emergency Operations Plan are in effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the copies of this resolution be filed with the County Clerk and Recorder, County Assessor and the Montana Disaster and Emergency Services Division in Helena, MT.


