

RESOLUTION NO. 2020- 21

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CUSTER COUNTY, MONTANA, A RESOLUTION DECLARING A LOCAL EMERGENCY FOR CUSTER COUNTY , PURSUANT TO MONTANA CODE ANNOTATED 10-3-402.

WHEREAS: On March 11, 2020, World Health Organization declared a global pandemic with the spread of the Coronavirus, (COVID-19). On March 12, 2020 Governor Steve Bullock declared a state of emergency in Montana related to COVID-19 with at least 16 positive COVID-19 cases in Montana and On March 13, 2020 President Donald Trump declared a National emergency due to the spread of the virus COVID-19, And

WHEREAS: the Custer County Commissioners considers the health, safety and welfare of all Custer County residents is of prime importance, And

WHEREAS: the County has committed all available resources to mitigating the impact of COVID-19 on Custer County residents, taken all possible action to combat and alleviate the situation. Local resources will not be adequate to cope with the situation, And

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CUSTER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS. An emergency is hereby declared pursuant to Section 10-3-402, MCA, because expenditures for responding to an outbreak will be beyond the financial capability of the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, copies of this resolution be filed with Custer County Clerk and Recorder, and the Montana Disaster and Emergency Services Division in Helena.
