

RESOLUTION 2020-9

A GRANITE COUNTY RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY DUE TO THREAT OF COVID-19 VIRUS AND ASSOCIATED HEALTH ISSUES

WHEREAS, Montana law at § 10-3-402 MCA allows the Board of Granite County Commissioner declare an emergency proclamation and disaster declaration; and,

WHEREAS, valid medical reports indicate that the new virus, Covid-19 (new Corona virus) is spreading in Montana and in the region, and is a real health threat; and,

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, Donald J. Trump, has declared a national emergency and the World Health Organization has declared the current Covid-19 virus outbreak is a pandemic; and,


WHEREAS, the Covid-19 virus with accompanying illness (and potentially even death), will likely result in Granite County from the Covid-19 virus and associated health issues.

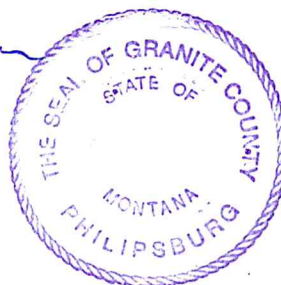
