Employees of Lincoln County,

As you may be aware, Governor Bullock has released a phased plan to bring our state back into a working economic status and usher in a period of "new normal". In addition, county businesses will begin to follow suit and open for business within safety guidelines set in conjunction with the county health department and guidance from our senior medical staff.

Although it's imperative that we continue to apply common sense social distancing practices, getting back to work and serving the public is also integral to the economic and emotional fitness of our community.

Therefore, starting Monday, April 27th the county offices and all services will be fully functional and serving the public. In doing so, we will revert to human resource and employee guidelines and schedules as before the Coronavirus-19 shutdown was enacted.

Please see the following social distancing guidelines as we do so, and endeavor to ensure that public guests are aware and compliant as they visit.

1. Masks and gloves will be provided for employees by request.
2. Clear physical barriers will be hung at customer service locations.
3. Employees and visitors shall remain at least 6 feet apart in line and at the counter.
4. Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer often, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces.
5. Sneeze or cough into a tissue or your elbow and avoid touching your face.
6. Disinfect and increase routine cleaning of frequently touched surfaces, such as countertops, doorknobs, and chairs.
7. Restrict use of common areas such as waiting rooms where adequate physical distancing cannot be maintained.

Thank you for your continued service to our community and the flexibility and patience you have shown in the last few weeks of turmoil.
