SINE DIE HAS COME & GONE . . . SO WHAT'S NEXT?

The 66th Legislative Session officially came to a close on the afternoon of Thursday, April 25th, after 87 days, 3,324 bill draft requests, 1,309 introduced bills, and 270,131 Floor Votes.

The Session adjourned without much flare. First the Senate motioned and received a successful vote to Sine Die, followed by the House, who completed the final vote on the budget bill ([HB 2](#)) as well as its two companion bills: [SB 352](#) (Generally revise laws related to the state budget); and [HB 715](#) (Generally revise laws related to state finance and provide for fiscal studies). Both bills were passed WITHOUT touching the Entitlement Share. We were successful in maneuvering around the hit this session, but the discussions will continue over the Interim, and we fully expect the struggle between facts and a preconceived narrative of some sort to continue next session.

WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

We have been and will continue putting together materials for our legislative wrap-up report, which will be presented during district meetings the first week of June.

THE INTERIM

During each legislative session, legislators identify issues they want to study more in-depth. They appoint interim committees to conduct these and other studies during the interim between sessions. The House and Senate leadership decide who will be on the interim committee; therefore, the members of the interim committees serve one 20-month term. The committees often invite experts to present information to them, and there is a public comment period during each meeting.

Legislators use what they learn from the interim studies to make decisions about what bills to consider during the next session, and most committees bring forward legislation.

Below is the list of study resolutions that passed the 66th Montana Legislature. This list was sent to the legislators to poll in order of importance—every vote is significant, because not all of the studies will make the cut. (The studies that were passed as bills are not polled, but they too are listed below, as MACo will be either monitoring them closely or participating in them as well.)

The study poll was due back May 13th, and Legislative Services is compiling the results by for the May 29th Legislative Council meeting. Legislative Services will provide a set of recommendations, and the Council will decide how to assign the studies to the various interim and statutory committees. We will know the approved studies in time for our upcoming district meeting tour and will provide the final list at that time.

We extend our gratitude to all county officials as well as legislative staff, Representatives, and Senators for your assistance and diligent work during the last 66th Legislative Session. See you in the Interim!
